Continuance: Student must maintain a grade of 3.0 or better in all acting core classes and a grade of 2.0 in all University courses. Students must audition annually for continuation in the BFA Acting program.

Graduation: Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 overall and in the major with a minimum of a B (3.0) in THEA 499, Senior Project, 120 credit hours, passage of the Exit Examination of Writing Proficiency, and completion of Senior Assessment. ???At least half of the hours completed in the major must be taken at Old Dominion University.
