All majors must complete the Lower Division General

one of the following concentrations. A cumulative grade  
point average of 2.00 is required for the 30 hours in French,  
German, or Spanish. No more than two FR/GER/SPAN  
courses taught in English can be counted for the major. At  
least 12 hours in the concentration must be taken at Old  
Dominion University. A maximum of three credit hours  
from FR/GER/SPAN 311 or FR/GER/SPAN 312 may count  
towards a minor and a maximum of six credit hours of  
FR/GER/SPAN 311 and FR/GER/SPAN 312 may count  
towards a major in both the Department of Foreign  
Languages and Literatures and in another department  
requiring upper-level proficiency. Courses other than 311 or  
312 which are required by another degree program may not  
be used toward a major or minor in the department.
