- A. Any approved non-business minor, a second degree, or second non-business major. See Catalog or contact appropriate academic department for requirements. *A double major or minor in ECON can satisfy this requirement. See the Undergraduate Economics Advisor for more information.*
- B. 9 hours from cluster courses for students pursuing professional baccalaureate (BSBA) \*\*\*Most Business students do one of the Clusters listed below, as one of the classes may be already a requirement in your major or CBK. When this is the case, you only need to do two more classes from one of the groupings below. **DO NOT MIX CLUSTERS!!** See Catalog for all options and pre-requisites.
- C. BSBA majors adding a minor or second major in CBPA: You must also take 6 hours of 2/400 level courses outside the CBPA, or in study abroad. Transfer courses will also satisfy this requirement, as long as the courses transferred are classes outside the CBPA and at the 2/400 level.
