Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 overall and in the major. All ECON courses are used in the calculation of the major GPA. Students must also earn a grade of C or better in ECON 201S and 202S, and must earn a grade of C- in each of the following: ECON 304, 305, 450, 454W, and at least four 300-400 level ECON electives. The remaining requirements include 120 credit hours (126 if foreign language I and II are needed), passage of the Exit Examination of Writing Proficiency, and completion of the Senior Assessment.
