Students who are pursuing a double major in COMM and THEA may use a maximum of two courses to satisfy requirements for both majors.

Emphasis in General Communication

24 hours of 300-400 level COMM courses from any combination of courses from the difference emphasis areas, plus three additional hours from emphasis or elective hours in COMM for BS students and six additional hours from emphasis or electives hours in COMM for BA students.

COMMUNICATION ELECTIVES:

A minimum of 18 credit hours of 300/400 level communication courses from any of the emphasis areas is required. Electives (to not include required courses for B.A. or B.S.) may include COMM 103R, 112R, 302, 368, 369, 401, 402, 469.

UPPER DIVISION GENERAL EDUCATION

Option A. Approved Minor, 12-24 hours; also second degree or second major.

Option B. Cluster, 9 hours (3 hours may be in the major area of study.)

Option C. Two Upper Division courses from another college or component outside of, and not required by, the major (6 hours).

Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 overall and in the major, no less than a grade of C in the major courses, 120 credit hours, passage of the Exit Examination of Writing Proficiency, and completion of Senior Assessment.
