Requirements for graduation include a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 overall and in the major. Courses used to calculate the major grade point average are all those with the ECON prefix. Students must also earn a grade of C or better in ECON 201S and 202S, and must earn a grade of C- or better in all other ECON courses except 301, in which a passing grade must be earned. The remaining requirements include 120 credit hours (126 if foreign language I and II are needed), passage of the Exit Examination of Writing Proficiency, and completion of the Senior Assessment.

BSBA majors adding a minor or second major in the College of Business: You must also take 6 hours of 200-400 level courses outside the CBPA, or in study abroad. Transfer courses will also satisfy this requirement, as long as they are classes outside the College of Business and at the 200-400 level.
